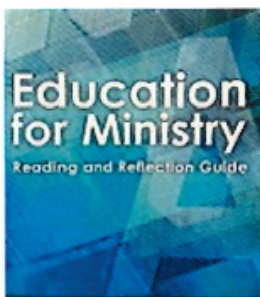


## Reading and Reflection Guides



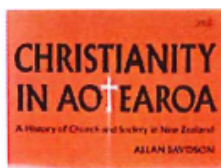
RRG Volume A

Each year of the EFM programme covers 36 sessions, divided into five units of study. A four-year cycle of Reading and Reflection Guides (RRG) provides the framework for each year of study, guiding participants through their text book reading with questions and reflections to stimulate their study and thinking, and to guide their group discussion

Volume C of the RRG is being used by NZ EFM groups that start their year of study any time in 2016. Volumes D will be used from the beginning of 2017, and Volumes A and B and will be used in 2018 and 2019 respectively .

### New Zealand Component of EFM

In New Zealand, the EFM programme contains a Unit on the history of the church in Aotearoa New Zealand. This unit includes Christianity in Aotearoa by Allan Davidson (provided by EFM NZ) and other contemporary resources.



### 2016 Registration Fees

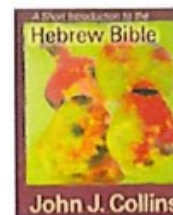
Registration fees are payable for each year of EFM study. The 2016 EFM Registration Fee is \$260.70/year.

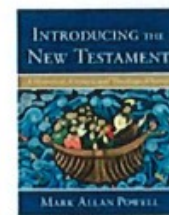
## EFM Curriculum

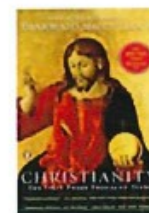
Books may change in subsequent years.



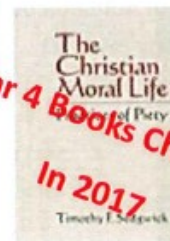
Year 1 Hebrew Scriptures



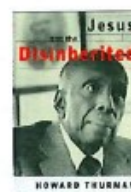
Year 2 New Testament
